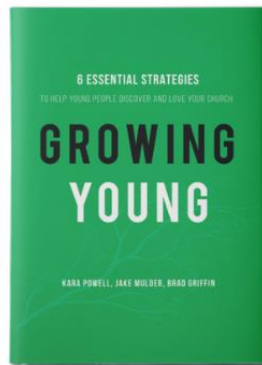




REACH CONFERENCE
